Competition Club is designed to train and prepare skaters currently enrolled in AAFSC's LTS program for participation in the Michigan Basic Skills (MBSS) competition series. Through this program skaters will prepare for an event at their individual level, learn the process of competing and attend a local Basic Skills competition. The program is intended to introduce skaters to the excitement of competition, improve individual skating skills, and foster feelings of accomplishment and good sportsmanship.

The WINTER EXHIBITION SESSION will include preparation for a solo in the 2017 Winter Exhibition (Sunday December 18th), the Winter Exhibition official t-shirt and the Competition Club Group number to be performed at the Winter Exhibition. Fee paid includes all of the above.

Competition Club staff will either work with the exhibition program choreographed by your private coaches or choreograph a brand new program specifically for the Winter Exhibition



AAFSC Refund and Credit Policy.

- ◆ There will be no refunds issued for Competition Club classes.
- ◆ If a skater drops the class within 14 days of the start of the regular scheduled session, a credit will be issued to the skater's account. After 14 days, a class can be dropped only for medical reasons with a doctor's note. All credits will be prorated from the date the class is dropped.
- ◆ Please see the AAFSC office staff if you wish to drop a Competition Club class. They may be reached during club office hours (see front of brochure for details).

Discounts.

- ◆ Persons signing up for 2 sessions a week will pay \$205 for the two classes. PLEASE NOTE: This price includes only one Winter Exhibition solo and one t-shirt.

Registration Requirements.

- ◆ All Competition Club skaters MUST be 2017-18 AAFSC Learn to Skate members or be a 2017-18 member of the Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club.

Skates, helmets and clothing.

- ◆ Rental skates and helmets are available for all classes at no extra charge. Helmets are limited in number and are available on a first come basis. Feel free to bring our own bike, hockey, or all-sports helmet to class.
- ◆ Helmets are strongly recommended for skaters under 5 years of age and all beginning skaters.
